

# Tom Seay *Keynote Speaker*

*Executive Producer & Host of the national television show, "Best of America by Horseback", America's favorite trail riding show" broadcast weekly on RFD-TV.*

Tom has had horses since he was 5 years old. He traveled America, taking people on overnight horseback vacations for nineteen years as a professional horseback outfitter. His largest accomplishment, as an outfitter, was organizing and leading "The American Transcontinental Trail Ride" in 1995. Pursuing a longtime dream, and after a year of logistical planning, Tom successfully led a group of horseback riders and wagons from Savannah, Georgia, on the Atlantic Ocean, to San Diego, California on the Pacific Ocean, every step of the way on horseback, over 3,000 miles.

The trip took four and a half months. Tom was hosted by 83 towns with 256 riders participating on parts of the trip. In 2009, Tom will lead another "border to border" trail ride, this time from Mexico to Canada. He hosted, directed and produced television programs for twelve years, specializing in outdoor sports programs. This weekly series takes viewers to some of the most beautiful places in North America still accessible by horseback.

Besides producing the Best of America by Horseback television series, Tom is a full time farmer in Virginia. His genuine "down home" farm boy personality and great sense of humor makes you feel like you've known him for years.
